### **About our Tutors**

CCGS is fortunate to have an outstanding team of Private Music Tutors who are accomplished professional musicians. Individual needs, interests and abilities are catered for and endless opportunities are created for our students. Requirements for Curricular Music classes are supported, particularly for Elective Music students.

### **Cocurricular Music Ensembles**

Performing in ensembles is the best way to maximise the benefits of learning music. All students enrolled in Private Music Tuition are expected to participate in the Cocurricular Music Ensembles appropriate to their instrument or voice. Singing in choirs is encouraged for all students, including instrumentalists, as well as joining multiple ensembles. Ensembles are open to all students, except for advanced groups which require auditions.

### Fees

The cost of Private Music Tuition is \$43.25 per 30 minute lesson. Tuition fees are billed to your School Account at the beginning of each term. One lesson per school week will be scheduled, except for public holidays, school camps or sports carnivals.

### **Instrument Hire**

Although it is highly preferable for students to own their own instruments, a limited number of instruments are available to hire from the Music Department. Instruments which are usually less affordable such as Cello, Double Bass, French Horn, Euphonium, Tuba & Oboe are available to hire. These instruments are more likely to create opportunities for students, due to vacancies in Cocurricular Ensembles. The cost of instrument hire is \$109 per semester.

### **Conditions**

Students enrol in Private Music Tuition for the entire school year. Tutors are allocated by the Director of Instrumental Music and parents should keep in regular contact with them to monitor students' progress and interest. Tuition will not be discontinued before the end of the year without consultation between Parents, the Tutor and the Director of Instrumental Music.

### **Attendance**

Music lessons are normally scheduled within school hours, by arrangement with the Tutor. Students should be punctual and bring their music, instrument, music record book, school diary and any other equipment necessary.

Students are expected to remember their own lesson times, with the exception of Infants students. It is not the responsibility of the Class Teacher or the Tutor to remind students of their times

#### **Practice**

To consolidate what is taught in music lessons, students are expected to practise regularly at home.

### **Absence and Illness**

Parents should contact the Tutor if a scheduled lesson cannot be attended [for example, illness or school excursion]. If a student is ill on the morning of their music lesson parents should contact the Tutor directly. If advance notice is given to the Tutor, the lesson will be rescheduled or not charged. Unexplained absences will be charged for.
